

Japan Sewage Works Agency (JS) will Sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Korea Environment Corporation (K-eco)

JS and K-eco will sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to establish a long-term cooperative relationship to strengthen global partnerships in sewage works.

The Korea Environment Corporation (K-eco) was established in January 2010 by merging the Korea Environment & Resources Corporation (ENVICO) and the Environmental Management Corporation (EMC), which were founded in the 1980s.

Its work encompasses all areas of the environment, including climate change, air, odor, and water quality monitoring, water and wastewater treatment, waste disposal, soil contamination, recycling, and renewable energy, and support for sewerage projects is one of K-eco's core businesses.

The main scope of cooperation under the MOU includes:

- Information exchange and joint research and development in the field of sewerage.
- Strengthening global partnerships and networks.
- Expanding areas of cooperation such as technology and personnel exchange.
- Developing capacity programs such as training and education.
