Japan Sewage Works Agency (JS) Signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Tashkent University of Architecture and Civil Engineering

JS and Tashkent University of Architecture and Civil Engineering signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to establish a long-term cooperative relationship and strengthen global partnerships in wastewater.

Tashkent University of Architecture and Civil Engineering, a national university in Uzbekistan established in 1991, is widely recognized as a leading institution in architecture and civil engineering.

On January 22, 2026, JS and Tashkent University of Architecture and Civil Engineering signed a Memorandum of Understanding. The MOU aims to establish cooperation in information exchange, joint research, and human resource exchange in wastewater projects. The signing ceremony was held at Tashkent University of Architecture and Civil Engineering, with President Kuroda of JS and Rector Abdukabilovich of Tashkent University in attendance.

At the ceremony, President Kuroda delivered a greeting to Tashkent University, expressing interest in cooperation and leveraging JS's long-term experience in wastewater improvement in Japan, along with its technical expertise, to enhance the wastewater project in Uzbekistan. Rector Abdukabilovich delivered a welcome speech, noting that this MOU is an ideal time for Uzbekistan, given the challenges of urbanization and untreated wastewater, and expressed expectations for a long-term relationship with JS.

Following the signing ceremony, JS presented its contribution to the wastewater business in Japan and proposed specific future collaboration operations. Tashkent University announced its focus on areas and joint initiatives with private companies. During the presentation session, an active discussion took place.
