The drama is set in a fictional country, the Republic of xxx, and the location of its capital is the familiar square in front of the parliament building in Ulaanbaatar and its surroundings. The scenery of Mongolia is quite different and varied from Ulaanbaatar, a large city with a population of over 1.5 million, and the surrounding area.

If you were fascinated by that TV drama, why not visit Mongolia? It takes about five hours from Narita Airport, and the vast nature awaits you.

Many Japanese people played the roles of the nationals in the Republic of xxx, but I did not feel any discomfort at all. As you can see, Mongolians and Japanese look alike. If you walk down the street, you will often meet people you think you know.
